2010 Season will open on Monday March 29, 2010

Sunday – Friday: Noon – 6:00 P.M.

Saturday: 9:00 A.M. – 6:00 P.M.

The compost site is open to the public during times listed above.

*Commercial tree services must report to the Transfer Station Office before entering the Compost Site: Monday – Friday 7:00 A.M. – 3:30 P.M.
Saturday 9:00 A.M. – 2:00 P.M.*

Rules for using the Compost Site:

- All loads must be secured.
- Yard Waste (Grass Clippings, Leaves, Plants Grown in Residential Yards Only)
- Brush and Branches (10 "x 10 ft.)
- Larger trees and logs(No Tree Stumps or Roots)

Compost and Wood Mulch:

Screened compost and wood mulch is available to residents at no cost.
Compost Site staff do not load compost or mulch for residents.

Fire Wood:

Get ready for winter 2010-2011 fire wood seasons, by coming to the Compost Site and get your fire wood. All residents must sign a waiver at the Transfer Station before cutting or taking wood. Contact the Transfer Station for availability of wood for cutting.
